of our campers, staff and families is our top priority. In light of the pandemic, we think it is important you understand our efforts to manage your camper's health and safety so that you can make an informed choice.

Kids still need the opportunity to get outside, interact with friends and have fun this summer. We understand there will need to be changes and new guidelines in place to ensure the safest summer experience.

Camp Crosley is taking rigorous steps to protect the health of your child. We have prepared and are ready to implement the measures listed here.

FOLLOWING GUIDELINES

We are closely monitoring government policy changes, CDC guidelines

and state/local department of health recommendations. We are in regular communication with our accrediting organization, American Camp Association, and Association of Camp Nursing. They have provided guidance of best practices for health and safety for this summer.

TEAM EFFORT

Camp Crosley is blessed to work with



a team of advisors that cover a broad spectrum of areas of expertise. The committee reviews our plan and helps ensure we are providing the best

possible care to campers and staff.

SCREENING FOR SAFETY

We will be completing a health screening of each camper and staff upon arrival to camp. Every day campers and summer staff will have their temperature checked and logged. By screening for illness, we are creating the healthiest environment possible so our campers can have the best week of their summer.



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


HELP FROM HOME

We know that you put the health and safety of your child at the top of your list. To ensure all kids have a safe and fun time at camp, we request that you keep your child at home if they have experienced a fever or illness within 72 hours of their Camp Crosley arrival date. We will require all families to complete a questionnaire prior to arrival.

TRAINING TO WIN

Every camper and staff at Camp Crosley is trained to keep their hands clean. For campers, we specifically cover good hygiene, including proper hand washing, during camper orientation on the first day of camp. Additionally, our staff is trained on camp's policies and standards for ensuring campers are taking advantage of hand washing stations, hand sanitizer and clean laundry.



KEEPING IT CLEAN

Our summer staff will lead cleanings in all cabins, bathrooms and activity areas using EPA disinfectant products with alcohol levels higher than 60%. Bathrooms, cabins and activity areas will have multiple cleanings/sanitizations per day with a focus on shared surfaces and high touch areas. There will be a focus on sanitizing shared items in between uses.

CLEAN HANDS, HAPPY HANDS



We will continue to emphasize with all of our campers the importance of hand washing, proper procedure, washing them as often as possible and using hand sanitizer when soap and water are not easily accessible. Outdoor hand washing stations have been added throughout camp. We will be installing hand sanitizers at every cabin, activity area and dining areas.



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KEEPING SEPARATE, STAYING SAFE

In the event that a child or staff member becomes sick with an illness that could spread, they will be moved to a designated isolation area and our medical team will implement a quarantine protocol that works to identify, control and contain the illness.



SPREAD IT OUT

We are putting limitations on the number of campers in all spaces at camp, mitigating large groups and limiting the number of campers in each cabin. In each cabin, there will be head-to-toe bunk arrangements and shower rotations. We are encouraging campers and staff to spread out and follow good social distancing guidelines.



FOOD SERVICE

We are taking extra measures in the service of our food to protect campers and staff. We will no longer be serving 'Family Style', but will be plating/boxing each meal. To make sure we are implementing best practices for physical distancing, our meals will be staggered in shifts.

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CROSLEY HEALTH HUB

Our health station is open 24/7 and is staffed with amazing medical volunteers who are ready to help, contain and treat illnesses at any time. Our health center has isolation areas for communicable diseases. We are enhancing our standard protocol for when to send a camper or staff home, based on current government directives and recommendations.
