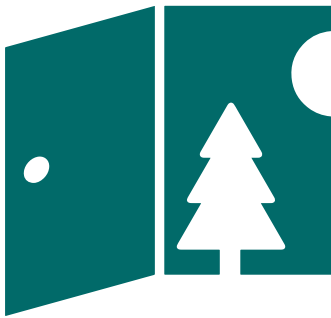

CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES

- Staggered times for both check-in and check-out
- 'Curbside' format
- Each family will receive an email one week prior to their arrival with their designated times and a detailed explanation of the process
- Check-in will begin on Sunday at 1:00 pm
- Temperature checks will occur at check-in
- Check-out will begin on FRIDAY at 4:00 pm



MEDICAL PROTOCOLS

- Temperature checks and health assessments will occur with campers and staff on a daily basis
- Anyone with a temperature over 100.3 will immediately be isolated and monitored for additional symptoms
- Parents must be ready to pick up their child shows any symptoms and continued high temperature
- If a case is confirmed at Camp Crosley, families must be able to pick up their camper



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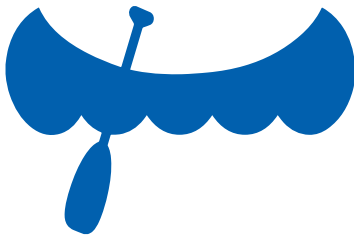
OPERATIONAL ADJUSTMENTS

CABINS

- Each cabin will have a maximum of 8 campers with two staff
- Bunks will be arranged so that the heads of campers on top bunks will be over the feet of campers on bottom bunks
- Hand sanitizer stations will be added at every cabin
- Cabins will be sanitized at least 3 times daily



CAMP ACTIVITIES

- Each cabin will be traveling together as a cabin or a program group during the entire session
- Each cabin, based on age, will be placed in a program group that will be comprised of no more than a total of 50 people
- Activity areas will have an increased focus on sanitization of high touch areas and shared items



MEAL PROCEDURES

- Every camper will be required to wash their hands prior to eating
- Staggered shifts, with only the specific program groups, will be eating in the dining halls
- Every meal will be plated/boxed by the kitchen staff and will be handed to the camper and summer staff
